Show Theme and Format

The theme for this year's spring show is, *A Night at the Opera*. We will be utilizing music from *Phantom of the Opera*. The show will be a hybrid of a production theatrical style show with many small group numbers. With this format skaters will have the opportunity to participate in more than one skating number and demonstrate their skating skills to the audience. A committee will decide the characters the skaters will be portraying. Please note that some of our female skaters may be asked to portray male roles in the show. Skaters that do not have a featured part/character will participate in a trio or quartet number to give all our skaters an opportunity to show off their talents. Our goal of this combination of production and exhibition style format is to allow more ice time during the show for all our club members as well as produce an entertaining production for the audience members that will bring people back year after year.

LTS skaters are being invited to participate in a spring show number. Their registration is being handled separate from the Club. LTS's practice ice time for the show will be at a different time from the Club's show practice ice time.

Participation Information

Practices for the show will occur on Mondays and Saturdays. Skaters should sign up for either Monday or Saturday practices or both. Certain numbers will practice on Mondays the other numbers will practice on Saturdays. If a skater is available for both days then she/he will have opportunity to participate in more numbers. One absence from either a Monday or Saturday assigned practice times will be permitted. Please note that once skaters are assigned to numbers a final practice schedule for each skater will be provided to them. A skater may not be required to attend all Monday or Saturday practices. However of the ones assigned the skater can miss no more than one Monday or Saturday. A more detailed practice schedule will be provided to each skater outlining the specific practice days the skater will need to attend by February 27.

We do have ice time during spring break. The spring break practice will not be counted against the skater as an absence as we understand many families will be traveling during that time.

Both shows and the dress rehearsal are mandatory for all skaters. We are also going to have a dance number that will be choreographed by Autumn. To participate in the dance number you must be currently taking ice dance. All dance practices are mandatory.

All skaters need to attend the full dress rehearsal on Thursday, May 10, 2011 from 4:30 – 7:40 p.m.

Show Participation Fees

The participation fee for the show will be \$50 if choosing one practice day and \$70 if selecting both practice days. The participation fee for the dance number is \$10. The participation fees will be used to pay for practice ice time and any additional collected above ice costs will go toward props and set costs for the show.

Costume Fees

In addition to participation fees skaters will be responsible for costume costs as well as providing costume pieces that are common items. Common pieces include but are not limited to skating tights, black skating pants or skirt, white shirt, etc. Additionally skaters will have additional costume requirements that will be provided by the club and paid for by the skater. The cost for these items will be covered by a costume fee. The costume fees will be kept as low as possible while still providing a great presentation to the audience. The cost associated with costumes will be determined by the number and the acts in which the skater participates. The costume fees for a skater participating in group numbers will not exceed \$15 per storyline. For skaters involved in multiple storylines as part of a group number the costume fees will not to exceed \$30. Once registration is complete and the committee is able to determine which parts skaters will fill, an accurate costume cost will be provided to each skater. We will strive to keep costume fees as low as possible.
